

David Veber is internationally awarded composer from Slovenia. He is mostly writing orchestral, chamber and choral music. He's works were performed in different countries in Europe (Slovenia, Croatia, Italy, Hungary, Slovakia, Great Britain, Austria, Italy...) and in different venues and festivals (Franz Liszt Hall Budapest, Pianorama Festival London, Zoltan Kodaly Festival, ISCM World Music Days 2015 Slovenia, Janus Festival, Samobor Music Festival Croatia, Slowind Spring Festival...). Veber collaborates with musicians and groups such as Sextet of the Munich Philharmonic, The Slovene Philharmonic String Chamber Orchestra, Brass Band Slovenia, Ensemble Janus Atelier, Ingenium Ensemble, Slowind Wind Quintet, Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra, Hugo Wolf Chamber Choir etc... Veber finished his studies in composition with prof. Marko Mihevc at Academy of music in Ljubljana. He continues his studies at Franz Liszt Academy of Music in Budapest with prof Gyula Fekete, among others, focusing on composition and music analysis. Veber also regularly participates in different workshops where he study with different internationally renowned composers and professors .He is also co-founder of Janus Atelier publisher group and producer of Janus Festival in Maribor, Slovenia.
